

Commons Act 2006 - Section 19 2(b)
Notice of application to correct the register

Notice is hereby given that an application has been made by **Kenneth William Philipson** ("the Applicant") to Cumbria County Council as Commons Registration Authority, under Section 19 paragraph 2(b) of the Commons Act 2006 and in accordance with the Commons Registration (England) Regulations 2014.

The application relates to register unit CL127 Kirkland Fell.

A summary of the effect of the application is as follows: Application number 661 was made on 10th June 1968 (the 1968 Application") and resulted in the registration of a right of common at entry 2 of register unit CL127. At part 6, the 1968 Application set out the O.S. field numbers to which a right of common was attached as: O.S. 18, 67, 68, 73, 166, 76, 78, 79, 49, 50, 60, 61, 62 and 72.

The Applicant claims that O.S. 72 is a public road, that it was listed at part 6 of the 1968 Application by mistake, that it never formed part of the dominant tenement and that it should not have been registered as such at column 5 of entry 2 of register unit CL127. The Applicant seeks by this application to correct the said mistake.

If the application is granted, in whole or in part, the registration authority will give effect to the determination by deleting the current entry and creating a new entry showing the right as being attached to O.S. nos. 18, 67, 68, 73, 166, 76, 78, 79, 49, 50, 60, 61 and 62.

Representations:

- must state the name and postal address of the person making them, and the nature of that person's interest (if any) in any land affected by the application and may include an e-mail address;
- must be signed by the person making them;
- must state the grounds on which they are made; and


