

**Commons Act 2006 – Schedule 3
NOTICE OF APPLICATION TO AMEND THE REGISTER TO RECORD AN HISTORIC EVENT**

Notice is hereby given that an application has been made by **Janis Wilson** (“the Applicant”) to Cumbria County Council as Commons Registration Authority, under paragraph 2 of Schedule 3 of the Commons Act 2006 and in accordance with the Commons Registration (England) Regulations 2014.

The application relates to common land register CL1 Watermillock Common.

A summary of the effect of the application is as follows: The right to graze 7 stints (amounting to 42 sheep) on Watermillock Common being 920 acres approximately and comprising the whole of the land in this register unit (“the Right”) is currently registered as attached to O.S. fields numbered 660, 645, 859, 863, 852, 840, 841, 850, part 852, part 781, 844, 873, 918, 919, 907, 906, 880, 816, 817, 818, 827 and 826 at entry 11 of register unit CL1 in the name of the National Trust. The Applicant claims that the proportion of the Right attached to O.S. fields numbered 852, 840, 841, 850, part 852 and part 781 was severed from the land and transferred to the Applicant under the terms of the agreement set out in the Minutes of the Meeting dated 23rd August 2002. The Applicant seeks by this application to register that severance in the register.

If the application is granted, in whole or in part, the Commons Registration Authority will give effect to the determination by deleting current entry 11 (making reference to the new corresponding entries) and by making new entries in the register to show the proportion of the Right currently attached to O.S fields numbered 852, 840, 841, 850, part 852 and part 781 as severed from the land and held in gross and the remainder of the Right as attached to the rest of the dominant tenement.

Any person wishing to make representations:

- must quote the Application No. **CA14/21**
- must state the name and postal address of the person making them, and the nature of that person’s interest (if any) in any land affected by the application and may include an e-mail address;
- must be signed by the person making them;
- must state the grounds on which they are made; and

Any representations made will not be treated as confidential, to determine the application it will be necessary for the commons registration authority to disclose information received to others, which will include the Applicant and may include other local authorities, Government Departments, public bodies, other organisations and members of the public (Data Protection Act 1998). Representations may also be disclosed upon receipt of a request for information under the Environmental Information Regulations 2004 or the Freedom of information Act 2000.

The period for making representations expires at 5pm on 19th April 2017
