NOTICE OF APPLICATION TO AMEND THE REGISTER TO RECORD AN HISTORIC EVENT

Notice is hereby given that an application has been made by **Windermere Aquatic Limited** ("the Applicant") to Cumbria County Council as Commons Registration Authority, under paragraph 2 of Schedule 3 of the Commons Act 2006 and in accordance with the Commons Registration (England) Regulations 2014.

The application relates to common land register CL155 - Two small parcels of land on each side of Windermere-Ambleside road, A591, south of Waterhead in the parish of Ambleside, Westmorland.

A summary of the effect of the application is as follows: The right of woodmere over the whole of the land comprised in this register unit ("the Right") is registered as attached to land at Wansfell in the parish of Ambleside, Westmorland at entry 1 of register unit CL155 in the name of the National Trust. The Applicant claims that the Right was extinguished under the terms of Deed of Release dated 2nd April 2013. The Applicant seeks by this application to have that extinguishment recorded in the register.

If the application is granted, in whole or in part, the Commons Registration Authority will give effect to the determination by deleting current entries 1 and 2 (making reference to the new corresponding entry) and making a new entry in the register to show the Right as extinguished.

Any person wishing to make representations:

- must quote the Application No. **CA14/22**
- must state the name and postal address of the person making them, and the nature of that person's interest (if any) in any land affected by the application and may include an e-mail address;
- must be signed by the person making them;
- must state the grounds on which they are made; and

Any representations made will not be treated as confidential, to determine the application it will be necessary for the commons registration authority to disclose information received to others, which will include the Applicant and may include other local authorities, Government Departments, public bodies, other organisations and members of the public (Data Protection Act 1998). Representations may also be disclosed upon receipt of a request for information under the Environmental Information Regulations 2004 or the Freedom of information Act 2000.

The period for making representations expires at 5pm on 15th August 2017.
