

**Commons Act 2006 – Schedule 3
NOTICE OF APPLICATION TO AMEND THE REGISTER TO RECORD AN HISTORIC EVENT**

Notice is hereby given that an application has been made by **David Jonathan Dixon and Sally Dixon** (“the Applicants”) to Cumbria County Council as Commons Registration Authority, under Schedule 3 of the Commons Act 2006 and in accordance with the Commons Registration (England) Regulations 2014.

The application relates to common land register units CL54 Hellgill Howe and CL95 Hartley Common.

A summary of the effect of the application is as follows: The right to graze 350 ewes with their unweaned lambs and 130 gimmer hogs over the whole of the land in register units CL54 and CL95 (“the Right”) is currently registered as attached to Ladthwaite Farm, Hartley comprising O.S. plots numbered 215, 216, 219, 220 and the land shown coloured blue on the supplemental map bearing the number of this registration and O.S. plots numbered 267, 268, 270, 271, 272, 273 and 274, all in the parish of Hartley at entry 27 of register unit CL54 and entry 24 of register unit CL95 in the name of Jonathan Harrison Dixon and Constance Margaret Dixon. The Applicants claim that the Right was severed from the land by way of an Assignment dated 8th April 1980. The Applicants seek by this application to register that severance in the register.

If the application is granted, the Commons Registration Authority will give effect to the determination by deleting entry 27 of register unit CL54 and entry 24 of register unit CL95 (making reference to the new corresponding entries) and by making a new entry in each register to show the Right as severed from the land and held in gross.

Any person wishing to make representations:

- must quote the Application No. **CA14/34**
- must state the name and postal address of the person making them, and the nature of that person’s interest (if any) in any land affected by the application and may include an e-mail address;
- must be signed by the person making them;
- must state the grounds on which they are made; and

Any representations made will not be treated as confidential, to determine the application it will be necessary for the commons registration authority to disclose information received to others, which will include the Applicant and may include other local authorities, Government Departments, public bodies, other organisations and members of the public (Data Protection Act 1998). Representations may also be disclosed upon receipt of a request for information under the Environmental Information Regulations 2004 or the Freedom of information Act 2000.

The period for making representations expires at 5pm on 24th January 2018
