

**Commons Act 2006 – Schedule 3  
NOTICE OF APPLICATION TO AMEND THE REGISTER TO RECORD AN HISTORIC EVENT  
Primary Application - Severance**

Notice is hereby given that an application has been made by **David Jackson and Angela Mary Jackson** (“the Applicants”) to Cumbria County Council as Commons Registration Authority, under Schedule 3 of the Commons Act 2006 and in accordance with the Commons Registration (England) Regulations 2014.

The application relates to common land register CL39 Ravenstonedale Common.

A summary of the effect of the application is as follows: The right to graze (a) 150 sheep with their lambs or (b) cattle and sheep together on the basis of 1 beast equivalent to 10 sheep over the whole of the land comprised in this register unit (“the Right”) is registered as attached to O.S. plot numbers 284, 283, 526, 282, 281, 280, 279, 277 and pt 278 on the O.S. Map (Edition of 1915) of the parish of Ravenstonedale, Westmorland at entry 96 of register unit CL39.

O.S field number 284 and part of O.S field numbers 283 and 526 were transferred by way of a transfer dated 8<sup>th</sup> January 2004 (“the Transfer”). The Applicants provided a copy of the Transfer which states that it “excludes all grazing rights and all other agricultural quotas which might otherwise pass to the Transferee expressly or by implication”. The Applicants claim that the effect of the Transfer was to sever the rights originally attached to the transferred land. The Applicant seeks by this application to register the severance in the register.

If this application is granted, the rights attached to O.S. field number 284, and part of O.S. field numbers 283 and 526 will be considered to be severed from the land and held in gross in the name of the listed transferors on the Transfer from 2004.

Any person wishing to make representations:


- must quote the Application No. **CA14/62**
- must state the name and postal address of the person making them, and the nature of that person’s interest (if any) in any land affected by the application and may include an e-mail address;
- must be signed by the person making them;
- must state the grounds on which they are made; and

Any representations made will not be treated as confidential, to determine the application it will be necessary for the commons registration authority to disclose information received to others, which will include the Applicant and may include other local authorities, Government Departments, public bodies, other organisations and members of the public (Data Protection Act 1998). Representations may also be disclosed upon receipt of a request for information under the Environmental Information Regulations 2004 or the Freedom of information Act 2000.

The period for making representations expires at **5pm on 14<sup>th</sup> September 2018**.
