

**A Proposal by Cumbria County Council  
Section 19 of the Commons Act 2006  
Correction of the Register  
Apportionment incorrectly calculated**

In accordance with paragraph 18(1) of The Commons Registration (England) Regulations 2014 please find below a statement in writing describing the proposal and the justification behind it.

**Description of the proposal:**

It has become apparent that an error was made by the Commons Registration Authority when updating the commons registers for CL81 Dufton Fell and CL82 Dufton Fell (disputed area) in 2018 to record an apportionment of rights. The apportionment was based upon an incorrect acreage for field number 750 on the O.S. Map (Edition of 1915).

**Justification for the proposal:**

The Commons Registration Authority believe that correcting this mistake, and therefore ensuring the accuracy of the commons register would be in the public interest, particularly as the remaining rights are likely to be apportioned further.

Notice is hereby given that a proposal has been made by **Cumbria County Council** ("the Proposer") as the Commons Registration Authority, under Section 19(2)(a) of the Commons Act 2006 and in accordance with the Commons Registration (England) Regulations 2014.

The proposal relates to register units CL81 Dufton Fell and CL82 Dufton Fell (disputed area).

A summary of the effect of the application is as follows: An application for the amendment of register entries 87 and 105 CL81 and register entries 142 and 182 CL82 to record an apportionment was made on 11th September 2017 ('the 2017 Application'). The 2017 Application resulted in the apportioned rights of 36.95 ewes and followers and 34.04 hogs being recorded at entries 104 CL81 and 181 CL82, and the remaining rights of 39.05 ewes and followers and 35.06 hogs being recorded at entries 105 CL81 and 182 CL82. The correct apportionment at entries 104 CL81 and 181 CL82 should have been recorded as 38.56 ewes and followers and 35.52 hogs. The acreage of O.S. field number 750 was incorrectly transposed as 7.384 acres when the true figure is 3.784 acres. The Proposer seeks by this proposal to correct that mistake.

If the proposal is granted the Commons Registration Authority will give effect to the determination by deleting current entries 104 CL81 and 181 CL82 (making reference to the new corresponding entries), and making a new entry in the register showing the correct apportionment.


