NOTICE OF APPLICATION TO CORRECT THE REGISTER

Notice is hereby given that an application has been made by **Allerdale Borough Council** ("the Applicant") to Cumbria County Council as Commons Registration Authority, under Section 19(2)(a) of the Commons Act 2006 and in accordance with the Commons Registration (England) Regulations 2014.

The application relates to common land register unit VG75 Ellenborough Moor Gardens.

A summary of the effect of the application is as follows: Ellenborough Moor Gardens was provisionally registered as village green on 5th June 1969 under Section 4 of the Commons Registration Act 1965, pursuant to an application made by Arthur Ritson dated 25th June 1968 and numbered 906 ("the 1968 Application"). The provisional registration of the 1968 Application became final on 7th October 1982. The Applicant claims that the land coloured red on the attached plan ("the Application Land") was not included on the plan attached to the 1968 Application and that the Commons Registration Authority made a mistake by wrongly including the Application Land within the boundary of VG75. The Applicant seeks by this application to remove the Application Land from register unit VG75.

If the application is granted, in whole or in part, the registration authority will give effect to the determination by deregistering the Application Land, which will entail the addition of a registration amendment entry in register unit VG75 confirming deregistration of part, and the amendment or preparation of a fresh edition of the register map showing only the remaining land contained in register unit VG75 as registered common land and the Application Land marked as deregistered.

Representations:

- must quote the Application No. **CA10/44**
- must state the name and postal address of the person making them, and the nature of that person's interest (if any) in any land affected by the application and may include an e-mail address;
- must be signed by the person making them;
- must state the grounds on which they are made; and

Any representations will not be treated as confidential, to determine the application it will be necessary for the Commons Registration Authority to disclose information received to others, which will include the Applicant and may include other local authorities, Government Departments, public bodies, other organisations and members of the public (Data Protection Act 1998). Representations may be disclosed upon receipt of a request for information under the Environmental Information Regulations 2004 or the Freedom of information Act 2000.

The date on which the period for making representations expires is 5pm on 24 January 2020
