Application to register land at Scaws Drive Field, Penrith as a town or village green

**NOTICE OF DETERMINATION**

**Application Number: NL0064**

Notice is hereby given that Cumbria County Council, as the Commons Registration Authority ("the CRA"), has at a meeting of its Development Control and Regulation Committee ("the Committee") on 1<sup>st</sup> July 2019, considered an application to register land at Scaws Drive Field, Penrith ("the Application Land") as a new town or village green.

**Decision**

The Committee resolved to accept the application, and add the Application Land to the register of town and village greens.

**Reasons**

The Committee took into account a report written by the Commons Registration Officer ("the Officer"). The Officer's report made a recommendation to the Committee to accept the application, on the basis that the evidence produced by the applicants is sufficient to prove, on the balance of probabilities, that the statutory criteria for registration of the Application Land as a town or village green have been satisfied.

**Outcome**

The CRA has given effect to the determination by registering the Application Land as register unit VG143, which entailed the addition of a new register entry and amendment of the register map showing the Application Land marked as a registered town or village green.
