

**Commons Act 2006 - Section 15(2)**

**Application to register land at Cumrew as a town or village green**

**NOTICE OF DETERMINATION**

**Application Number: NL0057**

Notice is hereby given that Cumbria County Council, as the Commons Registration Authority ("the CRA"), has at a meeting of its Development Control and Regulation Committee ("the Committee") on 13<sup>th</sup> August 2019, considered an application to register land in the village of Cumrew ("the Application Land") as a new town or village green.

**Decision**

The Committee resolved to reject the application.

**Reasons**

The Committee took into account a report written by the Commons Registration Officer ("the Officer"). The Officer's report made a recommendation to the Committee to reject the application, on the basis that the evidence produced by the applicant is insufficient to prove, on the balance of probabilities, that the statutory criteria for registration of the Application Land as a town or village green have been satisfied.

**Outcome**

The CRA has given effect to the determination by rejecting the application. The Application Land has therefore not been added to the register of town and village greens.
