NOTICE OF APPLICATION TO AMEND THE REGISTER TO RECORD AN HISTORIC EVENT
Secondary Application - Apportionment

Notice is hereby given that an application has been made by **Jonathan Hope** (“the Applicant”) to Cumbria County Council as Commons Registration Authority, under Section 12 of the Commons Act 2006 and in accordance with the Commons Registration (England) Regulations 2014.

The application relates to common land register CL46 Uldale Fells.

A summary of the effect of the application is as follows: The right to graze 640 sheep with followers on Uldale Common comprising the whole of the land in this register unit (“the Right”) is registered as attached to Orthwaite Hall Farm, Uldale O.S. fields numbered 365, pt.367, 412, 411, 407, 406, 426, 425, 427, 428, 429, 430, 431, 432, 433, 405, pt.436, pt.435, 434, pt.391, 395, 388, pt.387, pt.386, pt.381, pt.396, 397, 398, pt.400, 401, 446, 447, 448, 455, 449, 450, 451, 452, 456, 379 at entry 20 of register unit CL46. The Applicant claims that part of the Right attached to O.S. fields numbered 365, 405, 406, 407, 411, 412, 425, 426, 427, 428, 429, 430, 432, 433, 434, 431, pt.367, pt.365, pt.436 and pt.400 was severed by way of Conveyance dated 29th November 1991 made between Mr R.T and Miss M.I. Barnes and the Applicant and Mrs J. Hope. The Applicant seeks to show by this application that the portion of the Right to be severed equates to 206.4 sheep with followers.

This secondary application can only be considered if the primary application (CA14/28) is granted. If granted, the commons registration authority will give effect to the determination by deleting current entry 20 (making reference to the new corresponding entries) and making two new entries in the register to show the proportion of the Right currently attached to O.S. fields numbered 365, 405, 406, 407, 411, 412, 425, 426, 427, 428, 429, 430, 432, 433, 434, 431, pt.367, pt.365, pt.436 and pt.400 as severed from the land and held in gross.


Any person wishing to make representations:

- must quote the Application No. **CA14/33**
- must state the name and postal address of the person making them, and the nature of that person’s interest (if any) in any land affected by the application and may include an e-mail address;
- must state the grounds on which they are made and must be signed by the person making them;

Any representations made will not be treated as confidential, to determine the application it will be necessary for the authority to disclose information received from you to others, which will include the Applicants and may include other local authorities, Government Departments, public bodies, other organisations and members of the public (Data Protection Act 1998). Representations may be disclosed upon receipt of a request for information under the Environmental Information Regulations 2004 or the Freedom of information Act 2000.

The period for making representations expires at **5pm on 19th January 2018**.
