

STATUTORY DECLARATION OF LANDOWNER
under Section 31(6) of the Highways Act 1980

To: Cumbria County Council

We, Philip James May and Carol Miriam May both of White Oak, 61 Main Street, Great Broughton, Cockermouth, Cumbria CA13 0YJ, DO SOLEMNLY AND SINCERELY DECLARE as follows:

1. We are and have been since 17 August 2009 the owners of the land known as Brewery Plantation, Clarghyll Head, Alston more particularly delineated on the plan accompanying this declaration and thereon edged red.
2. On 21 October 2009 we deposited with Cumbria County Council, being the appropriate Council, a statement accompanied by a plan delineating the said land by red edging which stated that no ways had been dedicated as highways over the said land.
3. No ways have been dedicated over the land edged red on the plan accompanying this Declaration since the Statement dated 20 October 2009 referred to in 2 above and at the present time we have no intention of dedicating any public rights of way over the said land.
