

STATUTORY DECLARATION
DEPOSIT OF STATEMENT AND MAP
SECTION 31(6) OF THE HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

To: Cumbria County Council

1. Mr Timothy Fetherstonhaugh, have been the owner since 1992 within the meaning of the above section, of the land known as the College Estate, in the Parish of Kirkoswald, more particularly delineated on the maps accompanying this Declaration and thereon hatched red.
2. On the 5th July 2011, Timothy Fetherstonhaugh, deposited with Cumbria County Council, being the appropriate Council, a statement accompanied by maps delineating the College Estate by red hatching which stated that no ways on the said maps and on the maps accompanying this Declaration had been dedicated as footpaths or highways over the College Estate.
3. No additional ways have been dedicated over the land hatched red on the maps accompanying this Declaration, and at the present time, we have no intention of dedicating more public rights of way over the College Estate.
