

STATUTORY DECLARATION

SECTION 31 (6) OF THE HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

We, Philip Edward Day and Debra Ann Day, DO SOLEMNLY AND SINCERELY DECLARE as follows:

1. With contracts now exchanged we will be the owners from 28th October 2010 (or before) of the land and woodlands at Hayton in the county of Cumbria more particularly delineated on the map accompanying this declaration and thereon edged red.
2. On the 15th day of September 2010 we deposited with Cumbria County Council, being the appropriate Council, a statement accompanied by a map delineating our property by red edging which stated that the ways coloured green on the said map have been dedicated as footpaths or bridleways and no other ways have been dedicated as highways over our property.
3. No additional ways have been dedicated over the land edged red on the map accompanying this declaration since the statement dated the 15th day of September 2010 referred to in 2. above other than those highways with footpaths marked in the appropriate colour on the map accompanying this declaration and, at the present time, we have no intention of dedicating any more public rights of way over our property.
