

SATUTORY DECLARATION

SECTION 31 (6) OF THE HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

IPETER JOHN BARTRAM.....(landowner)declare as follows :

1. I am, and have been since the 10th. May 1973 the owner of the land known as School Knott Allotments and land part of Blackmoss Farm (together 250 acres approx.) and I am and have been since the 27th. April 1998 the owner of the land known as Whasdyke Farm (90 acres approx.), the whole amounting to 340 acres approx. now known as Whasdyke Farm which is outlined on the attached map in red.
2. On the 12th March 1999 I ...PETER JOHN BARTRAM..... deposited with the Rights of Way Officer of the Lake District National Park Authority a statement (letter dated 12.3.99.) and map showing my property edged in yellow which stated that the ways coloured as specified had been dedicated as public highways of the stated status and that no other ways had been dedicated as highways over my property.
3. No additional ways have been dedicated over the land edged red on the attached map since the statement dated 12th. March 1999 referred to in 2. above. At the present time I have no intention of dedicating any more public rights of way over my property.

I make this solemn declaration on the 24th. May 2004 under the Statutory Declarations Act 1835 conscientiously believing it to be true.
