

**STATUTORY DECLARATION
SECTION 31(6) OF THE HIGHWAYS ACT 1980**

I Brian Fereday of The National Trust, Sizergh, Kendal, Cumbria, LA8 8AE, Forrester Warden, DO SOLEMNLY AND SINCERELY DECLARE as follows:

1. I am a representative of the owner of the land known as Sizergh('the land') more particularly delineated on the map accompanying this declaration ('the declaration map') and thereon shaded green.
2. On the 12th October 2009 I made a statement which was deposited with Cumbria County Council, being the appropriate Council, a statement accompanied by a map ('the statement map') delineating the land by green shading which stated that the ways coloured red with a dashed line on the statement map had been dedicated as bridleways the ways coloured red with a solid line on the statement map had been dedicated as footpaths no other ways had been dedicated as highways over the land.
3. On the 21st October 2009 The National Trust deposited with Cumbria County Council, being the appropriate Council, a statutory declaration dated 12th October 2009, stating that no additional ways other than those marked in the appropriate colour on the map accompanying this declaration had been dedicated as bridleways or footpaths since the deposit of the Statement referred to in clause 2 above.
4. No additional ways have been dedicated over the land since the statement dated 12th October 2009 referred to in clause 2 other than those bridleways and footpaths marked in the appropriate colour on the declaration map and at the present time The National Trust have no intention of dedicating any more public rights of way over my property.

AND I MAKE this solemn declaration on the 30th November 2009 conscientiously believing it to be true and by virtue of the Statutory Declarations Act 1835.
