Statutory Declaration pursuant to Section 31(6) Highways Act 1980

I, JAMES ROBERT MARKBY HOWE, the Rural Assets Manager of the Church Commissioners for England ("the Commissioners") DO SOLEMNLY AND SINCERELY DECLARE as follows:

1. The Commissioners are the owners within the meaning of the above section of the land known as Carlisle Estate and Newbiggin Estate more particularly delineated and shown shaded blue on the plans accompanying this declaration ("the Property").
2. On the 19th October 2011 I deposited with Cumbria County Council, being the appropriate council, a statement accompanied by plans delineating the Property by blue shading which stated that the ways dashed black with corresponding numbers on the plan have been dedicated as public footpaths or bridleways and the ways coloured green have been dedicated as public footpath or bridleways post 1976.
3. No additional ways have been dedicated over the Property since the statement dated 13th October 2011 referred to in 2 above and at the present time the Commissioners have no intention of dedicating any more public rights of way over the Property.

AND I MAKE this solemn declaration this *1st* day of *November* 2011 conscientiously believing it to be true and by virtue of the Statutory Declarations Act 1835.
