

STATUTORY DECLARATION



DEPOSIT OF STATEMENT AND MAP

SECTION 31 (6) OF THE HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

We the Landowner **HEATHERVILLE LIMITED** DO SOLEMNLY AND SINCERELY DECLARE as follows:

1. We are and have been, since 1994, the owners of the land known as Crossrigg Estate as more particularly delineated on the plan accompanying this declaration and thereon as coloured pink.
2. On the 2nd day of August 2010 we Heatherville Limited, deposited with Cumbria County Council (being the appropriate Council) a Statement accompanied by a plan, delineating the property by pink fill stating that the ways coloured yellow on the said plan (and on the plan accompanying this declaration) have been dedicated as highways with vehicular status; the ways coloured green on the said plan (and on the plan accompanying this declaration) have been dedicated as bridleways, and the ways coloured purple on the said plan (and on the plan accompanying this declaration) have been dedicated as footpaths; no other ways have been dedicated as highways over the property.
3. No additional ways have been dedicated over the land coloured in pink on the plan accompanying this declaration since the Statement dated 2nd August 2010 referred to in part 2 above, other than those marked in the appropriate colour on the maps accompanying this declaration and at the present time we have no intention of dedicating any more public rights of way over the property.
