

STATUTORY DECLARATION

SECTION 31(6) OF THE HIGHWAYS ACT 1980


I, MICHAEL SCOTT GRAHAM MILBOURN of Millfield, Torpenhow, Carlisle, Cumbria CA5 1JF **DO SOLEMNLY AND SINCERELY DECLARE** as follows:

- (1) I am and have been since January 1990 the owner of the land known as land in the vicinity of Hames Hall, Cockermouth.
- (2) On the 30th day of November 2010 I deposited with Cumbria County Council, Highways & Footpaths Department, The Courts, Carlisle, Cumbria CA3 8NA a Statement accompanied by a map delineating my property by red edging which stated that the ways coloured purple on the said map and on the map accompanying this Declaration had been dedicated as footpaths and no other ways had been dedicated as highways over my property.
- (3) No additional ways had been dedicated over the land edged red on the map accompanying this Declaration since the Statement dated 30th November 2010 referred to in (2) above and at the present time I have no intention of dedicating any more public rights of way over my property.

AND I MAKE this solemn declaration on the 5th day of *June* 2010 conscientiously believing it to be true and by virtue of the Statutory Declarations Act 1835.
