


STATUTORY DECLARATION IN SUPPORT OF
DEPOSIT OF STATEMENT AND MAP
SECTION 31(6) OF THE HIGHWAYS ACT 1980 AND
SECTION 15A(1) OF THE COMMONS ACT 2006

I, The Right Honourable Richard Hugh Baron Cavendish of Holker Hall, Cark in Cartmel, Cumbria LA11 7PL do solemnly and sincerely declare:

1. I am the owner within the meaning of Section 31(6) of the Highways Act 1980 and Section 15a(1) of the Commons Act 2006 of part of the Holker Estate of part of the Holker Estate. The whole of the said Holker Estate is hereinafter referred to as 'the Land' and more particularly delineated on the maps ('the Maps') accompanying the statement dated 26 June 2014 and thereon edged red, which was lodged with Cumbria County Council on 17 July 2014.
2. On the 17th day of July 2014, I deposited with Cumbria County Council, being the appropriate council, a statement accompanied by the Maps showing the Land which stated that:
3. There is no land dedicated as highways for mechanically propelled vehicles over any of the Land.
4. The ways coloured orange on the Maps have been dedicated or designated as restricted byways.
5. The ways coloured green on the Maps have been dedicated as bridleways.
6. The ways coloured purple on the Maps have been dedicated as footpaths.
7. The areas shown coloured yellow on the Maps have been used as common land.
8. No other ways over the Land have been dedicated as highways and we have no intention of dedicating any further highways.
9. No other area of the Land has been used by the public for any lawful sports and pastimes and we have no intention of dedicating any further common areas.

And I make this solemn declaration conscientiously believing the same to be true and by virtue of the Statutory Declarations Act 1835.
