Ground nesting birds

The surrounding access land is important for nesting birds in the spring and early summer. They are easily disturbed by people and especially by dogs running free. Please help to protect them by following the guidance below

- Between 1st March and 31st August you are requested to follow the recommended route shown on the map above

Dogs on access land

- Between 1st March and 31st August please keep dogs on a fixed short lead
- Note that any dog restrictions do not apply to guide/hearing dogs or if you are using a Public Right of Way

Dogs on Rights of Way

- Dogs must be kept under close control – preferably on a fixed short lead
