Kendal returns using the buses 552 or 555 and 99 connections

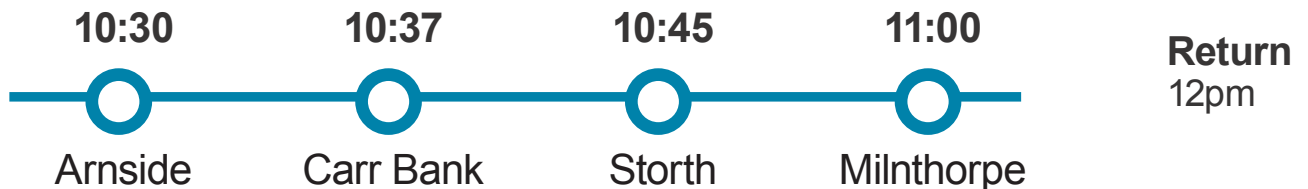
