THE COUNTY OF CUMBRIA (VARIOUS ROAD IN AND AROUND THE CITY OF CARLISLE) (TOUR OF BRITAIN CYCLE RACE) (TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION) **ORDER 2013**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable The Tour of Britain cycle race to take place the County Council of Cumbria has made, an Order the effect of which is to:

(1) Prohibit any person or vehicle from entering or proceeding along the lengthsof road specified in Schedule I below during the hours specified in Schedule I (or earlier if required by a police constable in uniform) until the time when normal traffic operation can be resumed at the direction of a police constable.

NB: Whilst the above restriction is in force, no person shall cause any vehicle to stop or wait (including waiting for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading a vehicle) in the lengths of road specified in the Schedule 1.

(2) Prohibit any person from causing any vehicle to wait at any time (including waiting for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading a vehicle) along the length of road specified in Schedule 2.

The restrictions detailed in I and 2 above shall not apply to any vehicle being used in connection with the cycle race, vehicles being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes, or the purpose of an undertaker in an emergency, such as the loss of supplies of gas, electricity or water to premises in the area, which necessitates the bringing of vehicles into those sections of road to which the order applies or anything done with the permission or at the direction of a constable in uniform.

Additional roads may also be closed at the direction of a police constable in uniform, to facilitate alternative routes.

The existing One-Way Traffic Restriction on English Street will be temporary suspended for the duration of the event.

. The Order will come into operation on 15 September 2013 and may continue in force for a period of up to three days from that date as and when the appropriate traffic signs are displayed, although it is anticipated the restrictions will only be required over a period of 2 days on Sunday 15 September and Monday 16 September 2013 or until normal traffic operation can be resumed at the direction of a police constable whichever is the sooner.

Cumbria County Council is satisfied that traffic on the roads detailed in Schedule I and 2 below should be restricted to enable The Tour of Britain Cycle Race to take place.

SCHEDULE I

ROAD CLOSURES AND ROLLING ROAD CLOSURES (Race Route in the Carlisle Area)

Between 0945 hours and 1145 hours on Monday 16 September 2013:

Wigton Road - From its junction with Church Street to its junction with Peter Lane; Castle Way (East Bound) - From its junction with Devonshire Walk to its junction with A7 Bridgewater Road;

A595 - From its junction with Peter Lane to its junction with the A596 Thursby Roundabout.

English Street - From its junction with Devonshire Street to its junction with The Crescent.

The entire lengths of the following:

The Crescent, Lowther Street, Drovers Lane, West Tower Street, Dacre Road, Devonshire Walk, Castle Way (West Bound), Hardwicke Circus, Bridge Street, Church Street and Caldcotes Roundabout.

From midday on Sunday 15 September 2013 to 1300 hours on Monday 16 September 2013 (except Tour Vehicles):

West Walls - From its junction with Annetwell street to its junction with Heads Lane; Fisher Street - from its eastern boundary of property No.16 to its junction with Finkle Street and also from its junction with Market Street to its boundary with the properties numbered 21 and 19.

English Street - From its junction with Green Market to its junction with Devonshire Street.

The entire lengths of the following:

Abbey Street, Castle Street, St Marys Gate, Finkle Street, Annetwell Street, Paternoster Row, Green Market and Bank Street.

Between 0700 and 1630 hours on Monday 16 September 2013: The entire length of Scotch Street.

From midnight on Sunday 15 September 2013 to 1300 hours on

Monday 16 September 2013

The entire length of the Millenuim Footbridge, which extends over Castle Way.

SCHEDULE 2 NO WAITING AT ANY TIME AND NO LOADING AND UNLOADING

From midnight on Sunday 15 September 2013 to 1300 hours on Monday 16 September 2013

Rickergate, Carlisle (East Side) - From a point 23 metres south of it junction with

Corporation Road, extending in a southerly direction for a distance of 73 metres.
