## THE COUNTY OF CUMBRIA (VARIOUS ROADS IN THE ALLERDALE AND COPELAND AREA) (TOUR OF BRITAIN CYCLE RACE) (TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION) ORDER 2013

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable The Tour of Britain cycle race to take place the County Council of Cumbria has made, with the approval of the Secretary of State for Transport under Section I6(B)(6) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, an Order the effect of which is to:-
(I) Prohibit any person or vehicle from entering or proceeding along the lengths of road specified in Schedule I below during the hours specified in Schedule I (or earlier if required by a police constable in uniform) until the time when normal traffic operation can be resumed at the direction of a police constable.
A way for pedestrians and dismounted cyclists will be maintained at all times
NB: Whilst the above restriction is in force, no person shall cause any vehicle to stop or wait (including waiting for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading a vehicle) in the lengths of road specified in the Schedule I.
(2) Prohibit any person from causing any vehicle to wait at any time (including waiting for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading a vehicle) along the length of road specified in Schedule 2.
The restrictions detailed in I and 2 above shall not apply to any vehicle being used in connection with the cycle race, vehicles being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes, or the purpose of an undertaker in an emergency, such as the loss of supplies of gas, electricity or water to premises in the area, which necessitates the bringing of vehicles into those sections of road to which the order applies or anything done with the permission or at the direction of a constable in uniform.
Additional roads may also be closed at the direction of a police constable in uniform, to facilitate alternative routes.
The Order will come into operation on 16 September 2013 and may continue in force for a period of up to three days from that date as and when the appropriate traffic signs are displayed, although it is anticipated that it will only be required for I day on Monday 16 September 2013 or until normal traffic operation can be resumed at the direction of a police constable whichever is the sooner.

Cumbria County Council is satisfied that traffic on the roads detailed in the Schedule below should be restricted to enable The Tour of Britain Cycle Race to take place. Whilst the road is closed by Order, traffic will only be restricted during the passage of the race on the direction of the police escort.
