Voluntary Social Car Scheme - Co-ordinator and Drivers needed in



What is the Voluntary Car Scheme?

The Voluntary Car Scheme provides transport to members of the community of any age (under 18's must be accompanied by an adult) who cannot make their journey by public or private transport.

What does a Volunteer Co-ordinator do?

Volunteer Co-ordinators receive requests for transport, then arranges Volunteer Drivers to provide the journeys. Collects and checks driver's claim forms. Helps recruit drivers and publicise the scheme locally.

What does a Volunteer Driver do?

Volunteer Drivers use their own car to provide journeys which are co-ordinated locally. Expenses are reimbursed.
