## Cumbria Pupil Librarian of the Year Award

### Nomination Process

A member of school staff (teaching or library staff) is asked to complete a nomination form, explaining why the nominee should be considered for the award.

The nominated pupil is also asked to describe their contribution to the school library, in writing, photographs or short video (or a combination of all three!)
